# Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 16.07.2015

The members of the internal quality assurance cell (IQAC) attended the meeting of IQAC held in Principal's office at 09.30 am on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2015 & discussed on the following agenda along with other matters of academic relevance:

- Drafting various academic activities of the college for the academic year 2015 16.
- Research activities and progress / 12<sup>th</sup> plan UGC guidelines / writing research projects by faculty members to various funding agencies
- Preparation of AQAR of the previous academic year; discussing scheduled NAAC sponsored seminar and other matters of academic importance.

At first, Dr. S. K. Sundar, Assistant Professor of Microbiology & IQAC Coordinator welcomed all the members of IQAC; introduced the external members briefly and outlined the agenda of the meeting including a scheduled NAAC sponsored two- day seminar organized by the IQAC.

Dr. S. Karthikeyan, Principal and IQAC Chairperson welcomed the external members of IQAC on his part as well as thanked all the members of IQAC. He conveyed his special gratitude to former external IQAC members for their scholarly contributions towards uplifting the academic performance of the college. He expressed his hopefulness that the members would continue to contribute their fullest as to upgrade the college as academically dynamic as required by learners.

Principal stated that the college has been academically catering to the higher educational needs of the regional students who represent socio- economically backward families; a majority of their parents are either daily wagers or small farmers. He underscored that neither real-time quality at higher educational level should be compromised nor learners turn out to be the victims of advancements / higher benchmarks in higher education that might not be accessible or compatible to them.

Dr. S. Karthikeyan, Principal also appealed to the members to bring out effective measures that could be transformed into fruitful academic activities and implemented for the welfare of the learners of the institution.

In this line, he was optimistic that the newly created auditorium would witness as many interactions as required for the learners at higher educational level during the days to come. He felt that students across the programs of humanities, literature, commerce, management and science of the campus could utilize the auditorium effectively either for their own subject presentation during department association meetings or to learn from internal/ external experts' presentations. He asked in particular, the HODs/ internal members of IQAC to induct the staff members of their respective departments to make use of the facilities available at the auditorium so as to expose the students to real- time topics of their subject relevance as well as placements oriented.

Subsequently, Dr. S. K. Sundar, IQAC Coordinator outlined the AQAR of 2014- 2015 and said that inclusion of other details in the report was going-on currently and be submitted soon after.

Dr. R. Saravanamuthu, External member, while inquiring about the performance and overall pass percentage of students observed that remedial classes are hopefully being conducted by teachers in the departments as to assist students whose performance is either below average or very poor. Senior teacher of the campus, Prof. S. Ravi, Head, Department of Chemistry responded in affirmative that remedial classes are being handled by teachers for needy courses/ poorly performing students either before or after their regular classes and added that the outcomes were beneficial to the target students.

On a suggestion by Dr. A. Paneer Selvam, External member/ Head, Department of Botany & Microbiology, AVVM Sri Pushpam College, Thanjavur, Dr. S. Karthikeyan, principal instructed that model questions of all subjects/ courses shall be prepared by the members of staff for the subjects/courses handled by them as has just now been suggested by our external expert and the same be compiled in the form of a question bank as to be available in each department. Dr. R. Saravanamuthu, a retired Professor of Botany from the Department of Botany, AVC College (Autonomous), Mayiladuthurai – 609 305, Nagapattinam District, Tamil Nadu said that circulation/ availability among students of a question bank comprising questions of various courses of their study would strongly assist their preparation during university external examinations.

On a request by the internal members and after due discussions, principal assured that an amount of Rs. 5,000/- and Rs. 8,000/- would be allocated to each UG & PG department respectively so as to meet out the charges of desk- top work while preparing the question papers as well as towards their print outs and binding. It was also resolved that Dr. K. Panneer Selvam, College

Research Committee (CRC) coordinator / Assistant Professor & Head, Department of Microbiology would coordinate the process of preparing a question bank along with Dr. S. Rajan, Assistant Professor of Microbiology.

The external member of IQAC, Dr. R. Saravanamuthu, inquired the status of previously resolved to publish a multi- disciplinary journal - 'MARGC Research Journal' by the college. Prof. S. Maran, Associate Professor & Head, Department of English and one of the members of the journal's editorial board briefed the on- going progress in publishing the journal and Dr. K. Panneer Selvam, another member of the Journal's editorial board and Assistant Professor & Head, Department of Microbiology complemented that the first issue would be published at the earliest during the academic year itself.

Dr. A. Paneer Selvam, External expert, underscored that every manuscript submitted by various authors from different spheres of studies for publication should meticulously be 'peer reviewed' so that the contents should carry every relevance/ originality; have a plagiarism checking thoroughly and have a higher influence among academic communities.

Both the subject experts also shared their opinion on the NAAC sponsored two- day seminar scheduled to be held on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> July 2015 which is being organized by the IQAC of the college. Dr. R. Saravanamuthu said that many departments of the college are recognized as research centers and that through an exclusive session, research guides/ supervisors as well as research scholars should be emphasized with the issues of plagiarism in writing research papers/ theses as teachers and scholars are to be well exposed with such real- time knowledge.

Dr. T. Paramasivan, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Business administration suggested to have a session on 'SPSS software and its importance in research data analyses' as the SPSS package is effective in analyzing large amount of diverse/multi-dimensional data. Members also discussed on the possibilities of having a few of the following topics for deliberations among the participants of the two-day event:

- 1. MOOC –Massive Open Online Courses
- 2. ICT in higher education
- 3. Role of computers in higher education research in particular

Chairperson / Convener of the seminar informed that the suggested topics were included in the proposal submitted to the NAAC itself. Thus, subject experts were being communicated by the organizing committee of the seminar and were being requested for the same, he said. He was

hopeful that suitable subject experts with good experience on the proposed topics would definitely be available and the above topics would have exclusive sessions during the seminar.

The external members also shared their views to improve laboratory facilities; staff members should come forward to write and submit mini or major research project proposals based on their research field of experience to obtain grant from state and national level funding institutions. Dr. A. Paneer Selvam, External member said that any such grants received would in parallel assist in upgrading science laboratories as well as in helping research scholars of the department.

Similarly, the external member informed that research guides should strive to publish quality research papers based on their funded research projects as and when going- on or based on the research work data of their research scholars. It was his strong information to the members that any research problem should be chosen which is basic/ fundamental and answers an important question and revolves around lab to land concept.

It was also pointed out that members of staff should submit suitable proposals to organize state/national level seminars/ conferences and workshops if funded by granting institutions. In addition, external experts and IQAC chairperson insisted on the following:

- To organize in-campus as well as extension activities through students enrolled in NCC, NSS, YRC, RRC etc., and to record the details appropriately.
- 2. To conduct Department Association meetings as a forum for students more importantly to display their oratorical skills on their program of study.
- 3. Students' visits to academic / research institutions and for field visits.
- 4. Usage of LCD and handling student classes with power point presentations for required topics.

Mrs. P. Senthamaraiselvi, Bursar/ Office superintendent requested the principal that suitable software required to be installed in the computers at the college office as to enable digitalization of preparing transfer certificates (TC) of all outgoing students every year as this would avoid any errors of handwritten TCs.

Dr. S. Karthikeyan, principal responded positively that initiatives are already being taken and the TC preparation would be computerized at the earliest. He also added that beautification of the path from college entrance to principal's office would also be taken up suitably.

#### Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 20.01.2016

The members of the IQAC attended the meeting held at Principal's office on 20.01.2016; meeting began by 10:45 am and Dr. S. Karthikeyan, Principal and IQAC Chairperson welcomed everyone and took up the agenda of the meeting straight away as under:

Principal presented a fact of increasing demand for admission to various programmes among students of the region after their higher secondary education and hence, he suggested that proposal could be submitted to the Government of Tamil Nadu asking for approval of new programs as to offer them in the campus.

Accordingly, it was resolved that proposals shall be submitted asking for M.Sc., Microbiology and B.Sc., Zoology programs against the facts that microbiology and zoology are being offered already as an under graduation program and as allied courses respectively and hence it was felt that commencement of the two programs would be a smooth affair at very beginning if approval is granted by the government. The respective HODs were asked to draft the proposal as to forward it to the Directorate of Collegiate Education, Chennai at the earliest.

Dr. S. Karthikeyan, Principal along with Dr. A. Paneer Selvan, External member/ Head, Department of Botany & Microbiology, AVVM Sri Pushpam College, Thanjavur, Dr. R. Saravanamuthu, a retired Professor of Botany from the Department of Botany, AVC College (Autonomous), Mayiladuthurai – 609 305, Nagapattinam District, Tamil Nadu insisted on the following:

Submission of research proposals by staff to state / national institutions for support & grant

To encourage students to participate in extra- curricular as well as in co- curricular activities

Department level placement training for students

To encourage PG students of science programs to prepare and submit a student research proposal to the Tamil Nadu State Council for Science and Technology (TNSCST), Chennai to obtain grant to carry out their PG projects.

All the departments should take some steps to have MoUs with other institutions/ university departments or with research centre to academically benefit the staff and students community

To consolidate and evaluate the students' feedback on curricula by an exclusive staff committee

Proposals for new buildings/ class rooms/ infra - structure

To convene old students' / alumni meeting by each department on a suitable day every year

Principal was hopeful of getting the submitted RUSA proposal approved for grant (RUSA Phase 1.0 under component 7 - Infrastructure grant for affiliated colleges) to the college. In this regard, he emphasized that the total sanctioned amount must meticulously be utilized for college development/ for student centric facilities and each department/ unit will have to plan accordingly. He also outlined that most essential needs of the institution like smart class rooms for the twelve departments, equipping the science laboratories with need- based instruments and equipments, construction / renovation of class rooms shall be planned.
